

# Music Ecademy Aural Training Curriculum

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## **Initial Grade**

## Pieces will be in a major key

#### Pitch

✓ Recognising Pitch - listen to the first three notes of a melody and identify the highest or lowest note

## Time Signatures

✓ Recognising 2/4 time

- ✓ Recognising dynamics in music as forte or piano
- ✓ Recognising articulation in music as staccato or legato

## **Grade One Aural**

## Pieces will be in a major key

#### Pitch

✓ Recognising pitch - higher or lower

## Rhythm & Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody and identify if the pitch or rhythm changed

### **Time Signatures**

✓ Recognising 2/4 and 3/4 time

#### **Scales**

✓ Recognising major and chromatic scales

- ✓ Recognising basic dynamics in music (forte, piano...)
- ✓ Recognising basic articulation in music (staccato, legato)

## **Grade Two Aural**

Pieces will be in a major or minor key

#### Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody, state if the last note is higher than, lower than, or the same as the first note

#### Rhythm & Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody and identify if the pitch or rhythm changed and say where the change occurred

#### **Time Signatures**

✓ Recognising 2/4 and 3/4 time

#### **Scales**

✓ Recognising major, harmonic minor and chromatic scales

#### Chords

✓ Recognising if chords are major or minor

#### Major or Minor

✓ Recognising if a melody is major or minor

- ✓ Recognising basic dynamics in music (forte, piano...)
- ✓ Recognising basic articulation in music (staccato, legato)
- ✓ Recognising the tempo of a piece of music

## **Grade Three Aural**

Pieces will be in a major or minor key

#### Rhythm & Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody and identify the bar in which the pitch or rhythm changed

#### **Time Signatures**

✓ Recognising 2/4, 3/4 and 4/4 time

#### **Scales**

✓ Recognising major, harmonic minor, chromatic, whole tone scales

#### Chords

Recognising if chords are major or minor

#### Major or Minor

✓ Recognising if a melody is major or minor

#### Intervals

✓ Recognising intervals by number only - 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th

- ✓ Recognising basic dynamics in music
- ✓ Recognising basic articulation in music
- ✓ Recognising the tempo of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising if the piece is in a major or minor key

## **Grade Four Aural**

Pieces will be in a major or minor key

#### Rhythm & Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody and identify the bar in which the pitch and rhythm changed

#### **Time Signatures**

✓ Recognising 2/4, 3/4, 4/4 and 6/8 time

#### **Scales**

✓ Recognising major, harmonic minor, chromatic, whole tone and melodic minor scales

#### Chords

✓ Recognising if chords are major or minor

#### **Intervals**

✓ Recognising minor and major 2nd, minor and major 3rd, perfect 4th, perfect 5th, minor 6th and major 6th intervals

#### Cadences

✓ Identifying cadences as perfect or imperfect

- ✓ Recognising dynamics in music
- ✓ Recognising articulation in music
- ✓ Recognising the tempo of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising if the piece is in a major or minor key
- ✓ Describing the character of a piece of music

## **Grade Five Aural**

Pieces will be in a major or minor key

#### Rhythm & Pitch

✓ Listen to a melody and identify two changes - one in pitch and one in rhythm, and identify the bars in which the changes occurred.

#### **Time Signatures**

✓ Recognising 2/4, 3/4, 4/4 and 6/8 time

#### **Scales**

✓ Recognise between major, harmonic minor, chromatic, whole tone, melodic minor, pentatonic major scales

#### Chords

✓ Recognising if chords are augmented or diminished

#### **Intervals**

✓ Recognising all intervals up to an octave

#### Cadences

✓ Recognising if cadences are perfect, plagal, imperfect or interrupted

#### **Tonality**

 Listen to a melody and identify the opening as major or minor, and identify any changes in tonality

- ✓ Recognising dynamics in music
- ✓ Recognising articulation in music
- ✓ Recognising the tempo of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising if the piece is in a major or minor key

- ✓ Describing the character of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising what period the piece is from (Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Modern)

## **Grade Six Aural**

Pieces will be in a major or minor key

#### Pitch, Rhythm & Articulation

✓ Listen to a melody and identify and describe the changes of rhythm, pitch, or articulation

#### **Time Signatures**

- ✓ Recognising 2/4, 3/4, 4/4 and 6/8 time.
- ✓ Comment on the main features of the piece (articulation, dynamics)

#### Scales

✓ Recognising major, harmonic minor, chromatic, whole tone, melodic minor, pentatonic major and pentatonic minor scales

#### Cadences

✓ Recognising if cadences are perfect, imperfect, interrupted, or plagal

#### **Tonality**

✓ Identify the key to which the music modulates as dominant, subdominant, or relative minor

- ✓ Recognising dynamics in music
- ✓ Recognising articulation in music
- Recognising the tempo of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising if the piece is in a major or minor key
- ✓ Describing the character of a piece of music
- ✓ Recognising what period the piece is from (Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Modern)
- ✓ Describing the texture/structure of the piece
